



Cytostatic and pharmaceutical contaminated waste

Yes please: Cytostatic, antibiotic and other pharmaceutical preparations with permanent toxic effects (AFS 2005:5) and materials contaminated with the above. For example, paper, nappies, dressings or gloves. Other discarded pharmaceutical preparations in different forms like patches, turbuhaler and intra-uterine device. Ampoules and syringes that contain residue

No thank you: Infectious waste.

Handling: Pack the waste in a yellow waste box. Fit the lid properly. Sealed waste boxes are not allowed to weigh more than 10 kg.

Waste from cytostatic, antibiotics and other pharmaceutical preparations with permanent toxic effects should be deposited in sealed plastic bags before being placed in the waste box. Other pharmaceutical waste does not need any special handling before being placed in the box. Use absorption cloth in the box if the waste is liquid. The box should be kept in a locked storage area.

Attach the label "Cytostatic and pharmaceutical contaminated waste" as well as the label for environmentally hazardous waste.

Material: Waste box, absorption cloth and labels are ordered by MediCarrier.

Huddinge: Send the waste box by way of the supply station (Försörjningsstation) to the in-house environmental recycling station (Miljöstation) S32.

Solna: Order pickup by the icon transportbeställning on the first page on Inuti. Or, call Servicecenter, tel. (585) 81 000.

New hospital building in Solna: Sealed waste boxes should be left on the AGV-cart in the recycling room.

Only waste that has been packed and labelled in a correct manner will be collected. If the waste is refused, departmental staff is to be informed of the reason.
